Jack Dossey Jr.— This veteran emerged to power as the 1990's decade began. The defending series champion also topped the class in 1992, 1993, 1995, 1996, and was the runner-up on three occasions. A record six Pepsi 100 and four One Hour Figure 8 triumphs head the list of his now 100 Late Model feature victories. His 23 seasons saw him top the main event wins list 6 times. His decade long duels with Lee, Reed, and Tunny headlined what arguably was the preeminent time in Late Model history. When the pink car (Dossey) is on the track, he is the one to beat.
