**#8 Kenny St. John– Even though the class came near the end of this driver’s career, he definitely made his mark. He won the division’s first oval, first Figure 8, and captured the first two championships. Seven short campaigns produced 25 wins on the dangerous crossover course and 19 victories on the fast oval track. The 1989 Speedrome Hall of Fame inductee was the perfect transition from Sonny Thompson to Wayne Arnold in the history books. Kenny’s biggest in class win came in the 1979 One Hour Figure 8 Endurance contest.**
