

DOSSEY, HAZELBAKER, COX LEAD SPEEDROME CHASE FOR THE CUP POINTS

Becoming a champion at the World's Home of the Figure 8® is a goal of every driver whether it would be their first title or just their next. The Chase for the Cup "playoff" format has brought a wide-open, exciting, and down-to-the-wire feel to our four Saturday night division campaigns. While this weekend is headlined by the 14th Annual Kenny's Auto Sales 100 for the Scooter's Auto Sales Stocks presented by Peters Auto Service, we focus this Speedrome news release on the Dad's Truck & Auto Late Models, 1-800-Radiator & AC Roadrunners, and Thirsty Turtle Tavern Hornets. All the racing action begins this Friday and Saturday night at 7pm.

Dad's Truck & Auto Late Model Chase for the Cup point leader Jack Dossey Jr had a pair of fifth place feature finishes last Saturday, but it was his qualifying prowess that helped maintain his standings advantage. Just 60 points separate the six-time champion and a trio of Tunny racers. Current runner-up Bruce is in quest of tying the title record held by Dossey. Bruce is a scant 20 ahead of son Mark and nephew Ben. The trio ironically occupied the most recent Figure 8 podium with Ben taking his second Late Model crossover victory of the year. 2004 Stock champion Corey Turner is next in the standings and definitely in striking distance of the \$10,000 season title top prize.

The 1-800-Radiator & AC Roadrunner Chase for the Cup has the tightest point battle at the Speedrome. After two events, just 5 infinitesimal markers divide the top four drivers in this championship quest. Veteran Rex Cox II has the lead after his league best fifth feature victory last weekend. A decorated brother combo is inside this fantastic four. June/July champion Kenny Smith and April/May king Kevin Smith have multiple wins on the season. Justin Dibbern splits the family pair in the standings with his three main events victories. Rounding out the top five is Roadrunner rookie Jordan McIntosh who has come oh so close to that initial feature win.

The Thirsty Turtle Tavern Hornet Chase for the Cup has two races under its belt with a new face atop the points. Judd Hazelbaker used his first win of the year on Saturday to be in the primary position for the first time in his career. He is trailed by 2010 division victory leaders Larry Hatfield who has 7 and Robert Eversole who has 3. Smooth and steady Rob Mink Sr presently resides in the fourth position. The two-time main event winner leads June/July champion Cassidy Worden by just 1 marker. A minuscule 15 points separate these fast five in the premier small car series.
