

INDIANAPOLIS SPEEDROME® REGISTRATION DAY INFORMATION 2010

The World's Home of the Figure 8® would like to provide car owners, drivers, and pit crews a description of the events during Registration Day for the 69th anniversary season. There will be plenty of practice time available leading up to racing on this special day at the Indianapolis Speedrome®. April 3, 2010 will mark a unique full day with a combination of Registration Day and Opening Night all in one. Many of the drivers have been through this registration process many times, but for some this will be their first participation in this very important day. And for others, these next few paragraphs will be a refresher of day's events.

First off, the gates for bringing your car onto the property will open at 10am. The gate that we will be using is the one nearest the corner of Brookville Road and Kitley Avenue. You will then bring your truck and trailer to the pit gate as you would on a regular night of racing. Please lineup in an orderly fashion. You will then go to the pit office to take care of your pit license (if you have not already) and purchase your pit pass.

Next, when you go through the pit gate you will be given a number. This is NOT your car number for 2010; it is a number for lining up for registration. This will help your team and our staff to process you through in an orderly and efficient manner. This also ensures you the spot in line without having a line of 80 cars clogging up the pit area. These numbers will then be called out over the P.A. in groups of ten or so to get into the line.

Once you get in the tech building, the first person you will see is News Director Scott Nigh. He will be conducting the car number and driver registration portion of the program. There will be a few items to deal with from Scott. First, the driver or car owner will fill out a registration card. Then, you will choose your car number for 2010. Numbers are first-come first-serve and must meet the guidelines set in each division's rulebook. This information is for the Speedrome website and for future use in the Speedrome Pit Board newspaper.

The next person you will be in contact with is Chief Steward Dennis Love. Dennis will, for the 28th year, be handling the inspection process. He will be checking to see that your car meets technical and safety specification for your class of racing. And you will have to receive the official inspection sticker from him before your car can participate on the track. He will also be advising drivers of the Speedrome rules of competition for 2010. You can pick-up your own copy of these rules and other information in the pit office.

Open practice will begin at noon and last nearly all afternoon. 3pm will be the deadline for teams to pay for their 2010 reserved pit spots (you can pay for them anytime up until this point). Soon thereafter, drivers will be called to the tech building to begin the spot assignments. After some more practice, we will begin the opening day of racing at 7pm for Dad's Truck & Auto Late Models, Scooter's Auto Sales Stocks presented by Peters Auto Service, Roadrunners, Hornets, Hornet Figure 8, Bandoleros, and Legends. It is the day we have all been waiting for!
