The 35<sup>th</sup> Annual World Figure 8® Championship Three Hour Endurance Race® presented by Pure Power Technologies & UAW the Greatest Figure 8 Race on the Planet® will be held September 8-10, 2011 at the Bryant Heating and Cooling Indianapolis Speedrome®. We are proud to announce that Kentucky drivers Chris, Mark, and Cory Harmon are entered for this colossal crossover weekend. This historic Figure 8 family has their focus set on winning the World title. They join a who's who list of intersection aces with the same goal heading to Indianapolis from California, Washington, Florida, North Carolina, and Michigan. 2010 World Figure 8® Championship runner-up Chris Harmon is one of the most decorated Figure 8 drivers in the country. He is a 4-time Extreme Figure 8 division champion at the Sportsdrome Speedway as well as their Midwestern Figure 8 series king in 2007. Just some of his Sportsdrome big event wins include the 2009 World 300, Ironman 2-Hour Figure 8 Enduro (2002 & 2009), and a record 4 victories in their 1-Hour Figure 8. At the now defunct Louisville Motor Speedway, Chris was Figure 8 champion from 1993 to 1997 and in 2001. Chris made his Speedrome debut in 2008 winning the Indiana Asphalt Shootout Stock Figure 8 series crown. Besides last year's stout result, his World Figure 8® Championship resume includes a 6<sup>th</sup> place finish in 2008 to win the Sonny Eaton Memorial award for top rookie and a qualifying race triumph in 2009. He is the son of 1986 World Figure 8® Champion Rance Harmon.

Mark Harmon took the World Figure 8® Championship by storm in 2005. His rookie effort produced a qualifying race win and a record-tying runner-up freshman finish in the main event. In 4 additional starts, he has impressive results of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> with 55 career laps led on his stat sheet. Mark tacked on 2 more qualifying race wins in 2008 and 2009. He has scored other wins on the Speedrome surface including the Snowball 100 in 2006 and a One Hour Figure 8 in 2008. Mark takes most of his laps at the Sportsdrome Speedway where he won the Figure 8 championship in 2004 and was crowned the inaugural champion of the Midwestern Figure 8 series in 2005. This year, he became the first-ever 3-time winner of the Ironman 2-Hour Figure 8 Enduro. He is the son of 2-time Sportsdrome Speedway champion Larry Harmon.

Cory Harmon is set to make a run at the Sonny Eaton Memorial Rookie-of-the-Race award in 2011. This hard-charger has successfully risen through the ranks from Bomber Figure 8 to the top level Extreme Figure 8 division at the Sportsdrome Speedway. His major Sportsdrome win came in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Sportsdrome Twisted 50 in 2010. He was a career best runner-up in the 2010 Extreme Figure 8 championship point standings to his cousin Chris. His only Indianapolis Speedrome® start resulted in a victory in the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Snowball 100 back in 2009. Cory looks to make his mark here in September. The Harmon name is synonymous with Figure 8 racing and we are excited to have them at the World Figure 8® Championship.
