It gets our team more and more excited each time". He added, "I can't wait to get back to the Speedrome". Family is a big word in the sport of Figure 8 racing and the Herne's are a perfect example. Dad turns the wrenches while sons Charles (aka Chuckie) and Neil do the driving. They have made many friends and acquaintances in Indianapolis including one with Peters Auto Service. Proprietor Dave Peters has opened his shop for them in the past few seasons during the September classic and will do so again this year.

The Herne Family first made the long adventurous trip to Indianapolis in 2007. That year was a valuable learning experience and saw the team return home to build some more high-powered machines. That was the way to go as Neil garnered the group's first Figure 8 feature victory at the Citrus County Speedway on June 21, 2008. The guys tackled the World Figure 8® Tour in February of 2009 at the Auburndale Speedway. Neil scored a preliminary heat win before Saturday's 100-lap main event. At the finish, Charles took home a very reputable 7th place finish while Neil followed in 8th. They returned to Indianapolis that September for a third go at the long-distance classic. Neil broke into the top twenty for the first-time finishing 19th.

Their stable expanded to 3 cars last year with Wallace "Gator" Jones taking the drive. He was a very respectable 25th after entering the event in 53rd position. Jones was the second highest finishing rookie racer. In 2011 that third ride will have another first-time World Figure 8® Championship driver in William Stansbury. This newest addition just recently finished 10th in a Citrus County Speedway feature. Speaking of that track, both of the Herne drivers are currently inside the top 6 in the championship standings. We are proud to have the Herne family back to Indianapolis for the Pure Power Technologies & UAW World Figure 8® Championship.
