VAN METER REIGNS SUPREME IN JAKE'S 150

1992 July/August Stock champion Eddie Van Meter scored his biggest Speedrome triumph last Saturday night in the Ward's Apparel Jake's 150 for Jiffy Lube Late Models. "So far this year our car has just been starting to get good at the end of the usual 50-lap Figure 8", said Van Meter "I thought that would benefit us in the longer races". And it did as Eddie pushed past defending track champion Doug Greig for the final lead change on lap 108.



Eddie and car owner Billy Skiles of Skiles Country Auto Parts have other notable Figure 8 wins to their credit. The combo won a pair of One Hour Figure 8 Endurance races. One in 1995 at the Jeffersonville Sportsdrome and another in 1996 at Sunshine Speedway in Florida during the America's Figure 8 challenge years.

This also continues the amazing hot streak that car builder Audie Moose of NASA Race Cars has in the Jake's races. It was the 5th time in the 7 year event history that a car he constructed went to victory lane. The list also includes two-time winner RJ Norton Jr, '03 winner Curtis McMurtrey, and '01 winner Rodney Sizemore.



PERSISTENT POTTER RETURNS TO VICTORY LANE

The next generation of the famed Potter Family, Danny, showed all his critics wrong by winning last Friday's Carmel Sod Modified main. He went flag-to-flag for the victory over last years top rookie Joe Jennings and two-time series champion Jim Begley Jr. It was the second career win for Danny, but one of many for the family at the Speedrome. His father Kevin has tasted checkers five times here in the USAC Regional Midget series. Relatives David and Tracy also scored features. Kevin also finished 3rd in the historic 1986 Indy Midget 500.

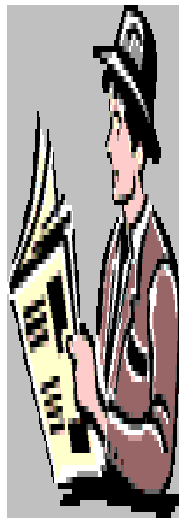

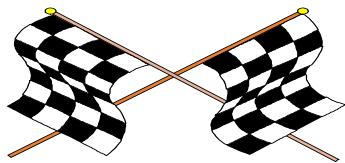

Jiffy Lube Late Model Jake's 150

The 7th Annual Jake Cohen Memorial 150 Lap Jiffy Lube Late Model Figure 8 - A strong grid of Jiffy Lube Late Model feature winning drivers was assembled for the richest race on the season calendar. Scattered early afternoon showers



forced the cancellation of time trials. The starting grid was to be set by using the season Figure 8 rankings and an invert draw by the top ranked driver RJ Norton Jr. He drew a 5 to position veteran Fred Bear Jr on the pole and defending track champion Doug Greig on the outside front row. The remaining 21 starters pulled to the grid in anticipation for the scheduled 150 hard fought laps ahead. Regional recording artist Sonja Meyers sang the national anthem and Don Walker gave the roster their due during drivers introduction. And Flag-to-flag television coverage was the newest addition to the prestigious Jake's 150 event.

The green flag flew with Greig getting the best of Bear on the start as the ceremonial fireworks lit up the night sky in honor of the late Cohen family patriarch Jake. Six-time World Figure 8 champion Jack Dossey Jr slotted into an early third as a quick pace began because of the threat of more bad weather. The hot fight for second between Bear and Dossey raged until lap 20. That circuit saw the two split around the lapped car of Donnie Garrigus III, but when they got past the two drivers made contact resulting in a flat tire for Dossey. He made a stop to replace the rubber losing just 3 laps.

On lap 24, Bear's runner-up run would end as he and the lapped car of Ronnie Rigdon came together in turn three breaking Fred's ride for the night. Two-time Jake's 150 winner RJ Norton Jr was now in second, but far behind the ever-growing huge lead of Doug Greig. During this mid-race string Mark Tunny was pushing the limits of the crossover because a large pack of drivers were grouped together while Marks had to pass through the "X". The timing ran out just once, he and 2003 race winner Curtis McMurtrey made contact sending Curtis spinning. Amazingly both cars continued on with very little ground lost.

The other notable incident came on lap 72. 1988 World Figure 8 champion Leonard Basham was attempting to split Steve Frost and Garrigus at the crossover. He had to tap on the brakes to avoid hitting Frost causing Donnie to hit Basham in the side. The incident was enough to bring out the red flag. The damage was sufficient enough to sideline the #9 machine of the Jeffersonville, Indiana driver for the evening.

The restart saw five drivers left on the lead lap and all right together on the track. In order they were Greig, former Stock champion Eddie Van Meter, Norton, 2004 race winner Bruce Tunny, and Mark Tunny. The first to drop off of this status was Bruce as his handling went away near the 100-lap mark. The raging battle for the top spot saw Greig and Van Meter trade paint on several occasions. This came to a head on lap 107 when the duo's contact loosened Doug's car enough for Eddie to take the lead. Norton then followed him through for second. Greig's awesome speed would never surface again.

New third running driver Mark Tunny joined this tussle for the \$2000 first place prize. During this last portion of the classic contest, rain sprinkles were becoming now more present in the atmosphere. The lead trio was now an expanding and contracting battle that was very entertaining to watch. EVM continued to show the way.

On lap number 138 the red flag flew because of the every increasing showers. This circumstance brought the race to a premature end with Eddie Van Meter

claiming his first Jake Cohen Memorial 150 title. The journeyman driver scored the biggest victory of his Figure 8 career. RJ Norton Jr continued his amazing Jake's race success with the runner-up result while Mark Tunny claimed third place for the second straight year. 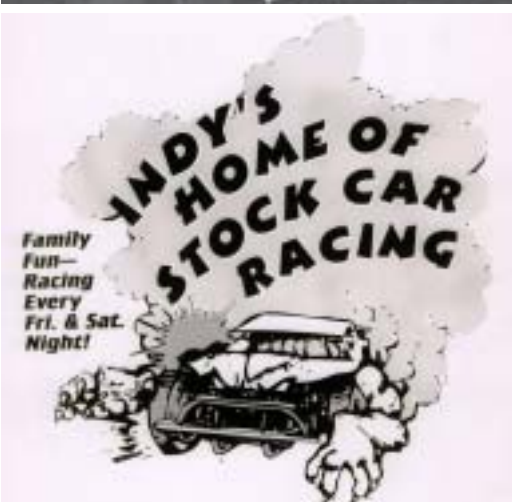
